I had significant damage to newly grafted trees from grasshoppers last season. These were my own grafts (Ashmead's kernel, Blue Permain, Winekist, etc.) on feral rootstocks in a 'rough', largely unmanaged part of the property. I found a passage in "The Holistic Orchard" suggesting the use of wild lettuce tea to discourage grasshoppers, but that is all I've found - a search on this site came up blank. Next drought though, which is just a matter of time, I have chosen to use Bill Mollisons' thoughts "you don't have a grasshopper problem you have a chicken deficiency"
