Always curious which biology has been called to the fore to outcompete disease. PreStop turns out to be spores and mycelia of *Gliocladium catenulatum* strain J1446, a naturally occurring soil fungus. AgBio is making this available in the states but here's a <u>Swiss flyer</u> about it. Those of you in the Pacific Northwest need to nail down the timing for anthracnose and share results here. I would certainly think about culturing this fungus from a first-time purchase and making it your own.
